The word “Tribulation”

6 words the Spirit uses to speak of the Tribulation:

Wrath, punishment, judgment, vengeance, visitation, indignation

A. The judgments of the 1st half of the Tribulation
(chapters 6-9)

(1) Global results:

Global famine- 6:1-8

Global earthquake- 6:12-17

Massive volcanic destruction- 8:7-9

Asteroid breaks up in atmosphere- 8:10-11

Darkness- 8:12-13

Demonic invasions- 9:1-19

(2) Global response: Revelation 6:15-17

B. The judgments of the last half of the Tribulation
(chapters 15-16)

(1) THE wrath from heaven (chapter 15)

(2) THE wrath upon the earth (chapter 16)

- (a) sores upon Antichrist worshippers
- (b) climax of global ocean contamination
- (c) climax of global fresh water contamination
- (d) climax of global warming
- (e) climax of global darkness
- (f) climax of global wars
- (g) climax of global geological holocaust

Conclusions: Romans 12:17-19

| 1. He is righteous | focus on His person |
| 2. He is eternal | focus on His presence |
| 3. He is omnipotent | focus on His power |
